Program Details

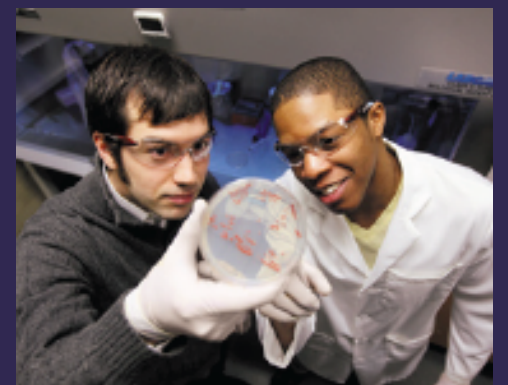
Ten weeks of mentored, research-intensive activities, workshops and seminars in the field of Synthetic Biology, including:

- Stipend, travel expenses, and room and board



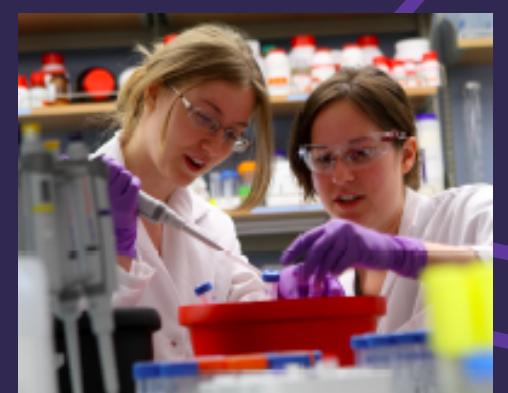
Application
